Rules and Guidelines

- All fairy houses must appear to be made of entirely natural components. Hot glue, acrylic spray, twine, wire, and other man-made materials may be used but must be concealed by natural materials. Purchased fairy furniture and accessories may be used but must be weather-proof and ACNC is not responsible for loss of or damage to items.
- Houses only please! No fairies or figurines.
- Houses must be portable and no larger than 12"x12" at base and 24" high. Houses may be designed to hang.
- Sturdy platforms of synthetic materials are permitted (and encouraged) for ease of transport and delivery. Whenever possible, platforms should be decorated or concealed to appear natural.
- Fairy houses should be fairly durable to weather elements. Because of this, items **should not** be constructed out of paper products (i.e. cardboard, corrugate, paper boxes, etc.). Examples of **acceptable** materials include dry grasses, leaves, wood, sticks, bark, pebbles, pine cones, stones, acorns, seaweed, nuts, shells, beach glass, and much more. Decorate your house inside and out. This can include landscaping and any indoor furnishings you wish to add.
- **Please Avoid:** seeds of invasive species, valuable materials (ACNC is not responsible for any loss or damage that may occur), paper products (they disintegrate in the weather), the harming of any living plants or fungi in construction, glitter, water soluble paints or adhesives, living plants (they need to be watered), bird feathers or nests, or scented materials.
- While it is understood that small children may need help with sharp tools and hot glue, please assist only when necessary. Allow your child to be in charge of the design, construction, and decoration.
- Judging is based on the following: how natural it looks, creativity, original design, attention to detail, and soundness of construction. There is also a people's choice award based on which house gets the most votes in each age category.
- ACNC will announce winners on June 18 by noon and all houses remain on display indoors until June 22, at the 4:00 p.m. conclusion of the event. Non-winners may claim their houses at that point or donate them to ACNC. The top two winning houses in each age category (Youth 1, Youth 2, Adult) will remain on display (indoors or out) until August 1. After that, winners may claim the houses. Any unclaimed houses by August 3 become the property of ACNC.
- Prizes are awarded to the first place winner in each category. Check online for more details about the event.
