Counselors-in-Training are teens seeking to gain experience working with children. Duties include set-up, clean-up, prepping materials for crafts and activities, walking children to the restroom with a buddy, taking children to the 'nurse,' walking behind the group, and counting campers. CITs spend much time observing the counselor to learn how to best work with groups of children.

Junior Counselors are older teens who have previous child care experience, but who are looking for more in-depth roles working with children. JCs supervise children during quiet activities, assist with planning, set-up, and clean-up, prepping materials for crafts and activities, walking children to the restroom with a buddy, taking children to the 'nurse,' walking behind the group, and counting campers. JCs may be alone with two to five children children.

CITs fees are paid by Bob and Kathy Frucella. The reason for the fee is that CITs count as campers, not assistants under NYS law, therefore taking a slot in the camp. JCs assist free of charge. The Camp Director will review the application and send an email to you and your parent/guardian with the camp session you are assisting with.
